Two long-term residents have recently moved away from the area, and returned to their roots in Sussex in England.

Mike and Angie Flude lived in Hayscastle Cross for 26 years, and were to be seen on a daily basis briskly walking the roads around the village. They were affectionately known as the 'The Walkers' or 'Mr and Mrs Fit' on account of their devotion to keeping themselves fit and active.

During their time in the village they contributed a lot of their time and knowledge to village life. They were active members of the History Society and supported many village events involving the group. Mike researched and wrote up a history of RAF Hayscastle, as well as doing a lot of detailed research into the area's churches and burial grounds. Angie took on the role of Neighbourhood Watch co-ordinator.

When the village website, newsletter and 100 Club were launched Mike took on the role of editor/organiser, and put in place much of the structure and organisation that we still use today. Mike and Angie also played a major part in the distribution of the newsletter and administration of the 100 Club.

When Hayscastle School was threatened with closure, Mike and Angie were very early supporters of the campaign to keep the school open and tirelessly worked to collect as many signatures as possible for a petition which was presented to the council.

Both are keen fans of aviation, and had a working background in Customs and Excise and the airline business.

We would like to express our thanks to Mike and Angie for their contribution to village life and hope they have a long and happy 'retirement' in their new home.
