The DPJ Foundation was set up in July 2016 in memory of Daniel Picton-Jones and aims to raise awareness of mental health issues. The Foundation is focused on supporting those who work in the agricultural industry, in particular men in the rural communities of Pembrokeshire.

Daniel Picton-Jones' wife Emma attended the January meeting of the Community Form, and spoke movingly and eloquently of her husband's personal struggles with mental health, and how the money raised by the community of Hayscastle will be put to use. The Foundation has organised a series of mental health awareness training workshops for those who work within agriculture to help them to recognise and support people with mental health issues. Future plans include establishing a counselling service and establishing a ground-up building project.

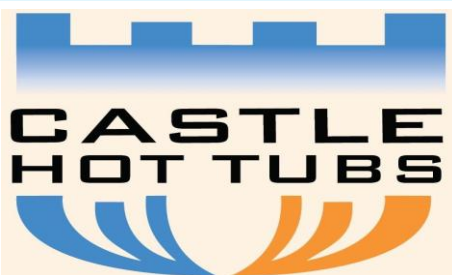

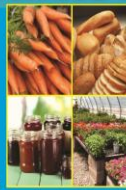
